- 1) Reviewing our three preliminary objectives, which span three core pillars of activity, to:
 - i. Conduct original research and quality improvement initiatives in COPD
 - Drive education of COPD and optimal COPD management among healthcare practitioners
 - iii. Promote advocacy for patients with COPD
- 2) Prioritising our plans and next steps for 2025 in order to meet these objectives
- 3) Raising the profile of the alliance, both through online presence and word of mouth
- 4) Expanding alliance membership across the globe and incorporating new members
